

## Behaviour Management Policy

**Rationale:**

All students have the right to safe learning and play.

**Purpose:**

The intention of this policy is to increase the personal, social and emotional safety of students during learning and play while at school.

**Guidelines:** The following procedures will be followed by all High School teachers.

Discipline	Behaviours	Process
Infringement	<p>Lateness (3 mins after bell)</p> <p>Self Management issues (disorganised for a lesson)</p> <p>Disruptive – (minor)</p> <p>Property abuse (minor)</p> <p>Disrespect to teachers / students</p> <p>Being out of uniform without a note or special permission.</p>	<p>Students will be issued a ‘write-out’ relevant to their behaviour. They will complete this during lunch time, until it is complete.</p> <p>Infringements must be recorded into seqta immediately by teacher issuing the infringement. Detention officer is to check high school whiteboard before duty to populate list of students. They will then communicate the names of students to admin, to call over P.A. system</p> <p>Detention teacher must acknowledge on SEQTA once infringement has been completed, and upload a copy of completed write-out to SEQTA. If a student refuses to complete an infringement, it must be followed up with the principal for further action.</p> <p>Each day, the detention officer will populate a list of infringements each student has incurred per term.</p>
Detention (updated)	<p>Bullying</p> <p>Derogatory language</p> <p>Denigration of others</p>	<p>After three infringements in any given term, students will receive a detention.</p>



<p><b>- Level Three: Red Card</b></p>		<p>Teacher to meet with the principal. Principal to call and meet with parents. Letter to parents with the report card (Student removed from all classes, recess and lunch, before and after school interaction restricted)</p>
